Attendance/Punctuality: Thank you for your continued support. Please continue to ensure that your child leaves home in enough time to arrive at school for 8.35am (taking into account that there may be travel delays).

Holidays during Term Time: Once again, we respectfully request that parents/carers refrain from booking holidays/trips during term time, as these absences have a significant impact on your child's learning. A list of future term dates can be found on our website to assist you with booking holidays/trips within our holiday timescales.

Catch-up Sessions: Further to requests from parents/carers to support lost learning due to absence and extended leave, we will be introducing compulsory catch-up sessions for students who take term time leave for holidays and those who are persistently absent. For each day of lost learning, your child will stay in school (commencing on the day they return to school) from 3.15pm – 4.15pm, to catch up on work missed. Students who have a P7 lesson will attend from 4.15pm-4.45pm. All pupils are welcome to attend these sessions, but they will be compulsory for the groups indicated. Parents/carers of children who must attend, will be sent a text/email on the day of each catchup session.

Durward Street and Brady Street get very congested at these times and are presenting a Health & Safety issue due to the high volume of traffic near the school.
