## **Year 10 Period 7 – commencing Tuesday 9th September 2025**

These sessions will run as an extended day every Tuesday from 3.15 to 4.15pm. If your child studies Computer Science, they will also have period 7 every Monday 3.15pm to 4.15pm.

Period 7 lessons are focused sessions which revise previous content from Year 9 as well as supporting students to practise key examination skills required for their GCSE subjects. Attendance to these sessions is compulsory and it is considered as part of the school day.

## **Mock Examinations**
